QUALITY STAYER **RETIRED**

New Zealand racing has lost another quality performer from its staying ranks with the retirement of the Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained **Maygrove** (Authorized) following an unplaced run in Saturday's Listed Gallagher Marton Cup (2200m).

Raced by Lib Petagna and Patrick O'Rourke, Maygrove won nine races in a 55-start career including the 2015 Gr.2 Wellington Cup (2400m), the 2016 Gr.2 Awapuni Gold Cup (2000m) and the 2017 Gr.3 Counties Cup (2100m).

Amongst a host of top performances, it is the Wellington Cup win that stands out most for Petagna's bloodstock manager, Bruce Perry.

"He has provided us with some wonderful memories, but I would rate his Wellington Cup victory at the top of that pile," Perry said.

"It is a terrific race to win, but for his co-owner Patrick

O'Rourke it was very special as he grew up in Wellington and had attended the meeting over so many years with his family.

"To own the winner of that race made for a very special day."

While Perry is thankful for what Maygrove has achieved over his career he is disappointed that the retirement has been forced by the current handicapping model operated in New Zealand.

"He is as sound as a bell and I have no doubt he is fully capable of winning more races," he said.

"It is just a shame that horses like him are being forced out by the handicapping as he has continually had to carry topweight in his races.

"He has been a very good performer, but the system just doesn't seem to be able to cater for this type of horse as they get older as there is no weight-relief available for them.

"Our staying ranks are thin as it is and seeing these horses being retired is a real shame."

While Maygrove may be lost to the current racing ranks he may still have a part to play in the industry in a new role.

"He will probably head to Blandford Lodge now for some time off before we decide what next for him," Perry said.

"I think he could be well suited as a clerk of the course

horse so that is something we can consider but he will have a wonderful retirement as he has earned it."

Perry also advised that quality three-year-old filly Peaceful (NZ) (Savabeel) could be headed to Eilerslie for the Karaka Million 3YO Classic (1600m) on January 26 after pleasing connections despite finishing unplaced at Awapuni on Saturday in her first run since an Australian spring campaign.

"The track was quite firm yesterday and the 1200m was too short for her," he said.

"She will take a lot of benefit from the run, so we will now make a decision on where we head next.

"The mile at Eilerslie will suit her so that could be the next target.

"We do have other options which include the Desert Gold Stakes at Trentham.

"If she does go to the Desert Gold then we would likely continue on to the rest of the Filly of the Year series after that."

The Gr.3 Desert Gold Stakes (1600m) at Trentham on January 19 is the sixth leg of the New Zealand Bloodstock Filly of the Year series which is currently lead by Media Sensation after her victory in the Gr.1 New Zealand 1000 Guineas (1600m).

LONG LEAF ON TARGET FOR KARAKA MILLION 3YO CLASSIC



Talented three-year-old Long Leaf is heading to Ellerslie

Long Leaf (Fastnet Rock) will head to New Zealand's richest race day to run in the Karaka Million 3YO Classic at Ellerslie.

The meeting for graduates of New Zealand's Karaka yearling sale features the Karaka Million for two-year-olds and the 3YO Classic which will be run for \$1 million for the second time.

In his lead-up to his New Zealand assignment, Long Leaf finished second in a 1400m-race at Flemington on January 1 when he was chased down by Social Spin (Toorak Toff).

"The race is on the 26th (January) and he'll leave the week of the race," co-trainer Tom Dabernig said.

"At the moment we've got a flight leaving either on the Tuesday or the Wednesday, and James McDonald is going to ride him."

The Karaka Million 3YO Classic is over 1600m, the same

distance as the Sandown Guineas in which Long Leaf finished third at the end of the Melbourne spring carnival.

"He ran well in the Sandown Guineas and I thought he ran really well at Flemington last start," Dabernig said.

"We had him wound up but it was a bit of time between runs and going to the mile in New Zealand we thought we would use the race as a good hit-out."

Lindsay Park considered taking Long Leaf to New Zealand last year for the two-year-old race but decided to target the Gr.1 Blue Diamond Stakes (1200m) instead.

Long Leaf won the Blue Diamond Preview before finishing unplaced in the Blue Diamond at Caulfield in February.

"He's a nice sensible colt so hopefully he travels well," Dabernig said.

"It's always a bit of a risk with travelling, how they are going to take the trip."





TRUE EXCELSIOR TO HEAD TO NZ FOR G1 SPRINT

Australian mare **True Excelsior (NZ)** (Exceed And Excel) is set to head across the Tasman for a crack at a Group One sprint.

Trained by Leon and Troy Corstens in Victoria and raced by Rosemont Stud, True Excelsior finished third in the Gr.3 Standish Handicap (1200m) on New Year's Day at Flemington in her most recent start.

That performance confirmed plans for the Gr.1 JR and N Berkett Telegraph (1200m) at Trentham on January 19.

Leon Corstens said the mare was scheduled to fly to New Zealand on Saturday.

True Excelsior is a multiple stakes placegetter including two Group Three placings at Moonee Valley last season as a three-year-old while her only attempt at Group One level was fourth in the Sangster Stakes for fillies and mares in Adelaide in May.

That form has encouraged the stable to give her a chance at The Telegraph.

"The race is there and it's a Group One. If you could fluke winning it, it would be great," Leon Corstens said.

"Especially for a mare."

Corstens said True Excelsior had come through her Standish Handicap run in great condition.

"We've taken her down the beach with another couple of horses and she's really come ahead in leaps and bounds," he said.

"You just hope that she cops the travel all right. That's the main thing."

CAMBRIDGE STUD COUPLE CONTINUE WINNING RUN

Cambridge Stud owners Brendan and Jo Lindsay continued their wonderful winning streak of late when talented galloper **Hanger (NZ)** (O'Reilly) resumed off a long spell with an eye-catching performance at Awapuni.

Bred by Waikato Stud, who share in the ownership of the O'Reilly four-year-old with the Lindsays, Hanger was having his first race since finishing runner-up in the Gr.3 Cambridge Breeders Stakes (1200m) at Te Rapa

back in April.

Sent out as one of the main fancies in Saturday's rating 82 contest, Hanger didn't disappoint as he bounced nicely from an inside barrier before settling in the trail for rider Leith Innes.

Innes had a lapful of horse approaching the home turn as he waited for a gap to appear before launching his bid at the 300m mark. Hanger responded gamely under a hands and heels ride as he eased past pacemaker Blondlign (NZ) (Align) to

score comfortably in a smart 1.09.73 for the 1200m journey.

Co-trainer Robert Wellwood, who prepares the gelding with Roger James, was delighted to see the classy galloper make a winning return to the track.

"It was wonderful to see him come back like that as we have had our frustrations with him," Wellwood said.

"He had a good long break over the winter and we brought him back for

some spring targets, but he has had a few niggles along the way which has held him up from making a return until now.

“We weren’t sure just how well he would go as he didn’t have the benefit of a trial under his belt and the pressure of raceday can find them out.

“Leith was able to give him a fairly easy time of it and he got the job done in fine fashion.”

Wellwood advised the stable would now monitor the horse’s recovery before deciding on the next assignment although a Group One challenge is an obvious target.

“He holds a nomination for the Telegraph at Trentham, so he had to have a run if he is going to take on that challenge,” he said.

“Provided he comes through this run okay then we will make a decision if that is the best option for him.

“With the set weights and penalties criteria of the race he is not well placed compared to some, but it is a Group One and they don’t come around that often.”

The Gr.1 JR and N Berkett Telegraph (1200m) is on January 19 at Trentham.

Awapuni proved a happy hunting ground for the James & Wellwood

partnership on Saturday as Hanger completed a winning double for the stable after talented, but injury plagued sprinter, Killarney (NZ) (O’Reilly) had taken out the open 1400m event earlier in the day.

QUIZMASTER KICKS OFF A TOP DAY FOR LAMMAS

Promising three-year-old **Quizmaster (NZ)** (Iffraaj) provided jockey Cameron Lammas with the first leg of a winning treble when he scored in the opening event at Ruakaka on Saturday.

The locally-trained Iffraaj gelding had opened his account on his home surface back in October before tackling age-group stakes company at his next two runs.

Saturday's rating 72 1200m contest against the older horses suited Quizmaster down to the ground as he settled just off the speed for Lammas before looming into contention on the home corner.

Asked for an effort at the 150m mark, Quizmaster dashed to the front before holding out the challenge of Mercy Hill (All American), who closed off powerfully after being held-up at a vital stage in the run home.

Co-trainer Michelle Bradley, who prepares the horse with Chris Gibbs, was all smiles when interviewed after the race.

"We have a bit of time for him and I said to Chris as we watched him walking around that I thought he was developing more and more," she said.

"It is nice to get this win out of him.

"You could see when he was coming down the straight that he is still green and learning the whole game, but I think we can pick-up a nice race with him later on."

Lammas was pleased with the effort after the horse had proved a little wayward at his last start.

"Last start he did things wrong," he said.

"Today the gear came off, and in a bit weaker field, he has won nicely.

"He's probably going to be a better autumn horse, so he can only improve more and mature more."

Lammas completed his winning treble on two further Gibbs/Bradley-trained horses with Final Suggestion (NZ) (Any Suggestion) taking out the day's feature, the Whangaripo Valley Free Range Egg Cup (2100m), after Boogie Easy (NZ) (Super Easy) broke her maiden status over 1400m two races earlier.

TIME LORD LIVES UP TO HYPE SECOND-UP

New Zealand import and Singapore Derby prospect **Time Lord (NZ)** (Guillotine) made amends from his debut defeat with a smart come-from-behind win on Sunday.

Seventh at his first Kranji outing in a race which saw his rider, apprentice jockey Mohd Firdaus subsequently

suspended for three months for failing to ride to the satisfaction of the Stewards, the Guillotine four-year-old turned in a performance which was more in line with the ability he showed at his previous racing career in New Zealand and Queensland in Group company.

Ridden by Glen Boss in replacement of Azhar Ismail (stood down by order of the Stewards) in the \$70,000 Class 3 Division 1 race over 1200m, the previous two-time winner (one win in New Zealand and one win in Australia) had the race shot to pieces when he sprang out of the pack at the 250m to settle a hotly-contested struggle to the

line.

Walker was delighted Time Lord had redeemed himself with that second-up victory, but he said it was owed mainly to the jockey's mastery in the saddle.

"It was a gun ride. He had to push one out of the way, but it's the rider who won the race," said the Kiwi trainer.

"He was bought for the Derby, that's the whole idea, but let's not get too ahead of ourselves as the Derby is only in July.

"He's raced by a good New Zealand owner, Matthew Goodson, and he ran some Group races in New Zealand and Brisbane during the Winter Carnival.

"He didn't quite measure up in

Brisbane, but he's a horse with a lot of upside. It's a little hard to get a line on his first-up run.

"It's also a bit hard to get a line on the Polytrack form. In the earlier races, it seemed to favour on-pace runners and later on, it seemed to suit swoopers."
