# LIGHT BUILD-UP SUITS FRESH LUCIA VALENTINA



Star mare Lucia Valentina steps out at Caulfield tomorrow as she continues her build-up to a clash with Winx in the Gr. 1 Cox Plate next month

s **Lucia Valentina (NZ)** (Savabeel) gets older her trainer Kris Lees believes he has found a new winning formula.

It won the mare a Queen Elizabeth Stakes at Randwick in the autumn and it could give her a Cox Plate this spring.

An important stepping stone for Lucia Valentina's Cox Plate bid takes place at Caulfield on Saturday when she contests the Underwood Stakes.

Lucia Valentina won the Queen Elizabeth Stakes at her second run from a break following a trip to Hong Kong, with four weeks between runs.

The Cox Plate is to be Lucia Valentina's third start this

campaign and again with a minimum of four weeks between runs.

Mal Ollerton, the travelling foreman for the Newcastlebased Lees, said the change had helped the mare.

"She'll race here on Saturday and then it will be a month into the Cox Plate," Ollerton said.

"It's a similar sort of thing they did into the Queen Elizabeth and that seemed to work out well for us.

"She's going as well as she's ever gone and she's a lot bigger than she has been in previous years. She's filled out now," Ollerton said.

Lucia Valentina is on her third visit to Melbourne, having

finished third in the 2014 Caulfield Cup and winning the Matriarch Stakes at Flemington last year.

Lucia Valentina has been inoculated for a possible return to Hong Kong in December after finishing fifth in the Hong Kong Cup last year.

"If everything goes well down here she'll probably head back over again."

Lucia Valentina is the \$4 second favourite in the Underwood behind the \$2.30 top elect Black Heart Bart (Blackfriars)who is chasing his second Group One win of the season.

Dual Group One winner **Tarzino (NZ)** (Tavistock) will race without blinkers in Saturday's 1800m contest as he treads a path towards the Caulfield Cup. Fellow Tavistock fouryear-old **Tavago (NZ)** is on a similar trail, while **Prince of Penzance (NZ)** (Pentire) continues his preparation to defend his Melbourne Cup title using the Underwood as a stepping stone.

# OLIVER CARRIES KIWI HOPES AT CAULFIELD

he hopes of a trio of New Zealandtrained runners at Caulfield on Saturday will be in the hands of one of Australia's finest jockeys.

Damien Oliver will continue his association with the Murray Baker and Andrew Forsmantrained Saracino (NZ) (Per Incanto) in the Gr.3 Caulfield Guineas Prelude (1400m) and he will also partner stablemate (La) Luna Rossa (NZ) (Written Tycoon) in the Gr.2 Thousand Guineas Prelude (1400m) and he will ride Xtravagant (NZ) (Pentire) again in the Gr.1 Sir Rupert Clark Stakes (1400m).



Damien Oliver will look to remain unbeaten on Per Incanto colt Saracino at Caulfield tomorrow

The 44-year-old successfully reunited with Baker earlier this month when Saracino claimed an impressive Australian debut victory in the Gr.2 Danehill Stakes at Flemington.

Oliver's last ride for the Cambridge trainer was a runner-up finish in 2008 aboard Rios (NZ) (Hussonet) in the Gr.2 Tulloch Stakes.

Saracino's performance is likely to determine if the Per Incanto colt will cope with 1600 metres in the Gr.1 Caulfield Guineas in a fortnight's time.

"I worked him on Tuesday and I'm happy with his progress," Oliver said. "I don't think the 1400 metres on Saturday will be a problem and this will be a good gauge if that's as far as he wants or if he can get a mile."

Luna Rossa goes into the Thousand Guineas Prelude off the back of her second placing when resuming in the Listed O'Leary's Fillies Stakes at Wanganui.

"I worked her on Tuesday as well - there's not a lot of her,

but she moves well," Oliver said.

Xtravagant will need to stage a major form reversal to feature in the Sir Rupert Clarke after tailing the field home in the Gr.2 Bobbie Lewis at Flemington.

"It's hard to get a line on him," Oliver said. "He feels well and he's worked and trialled well. If he runs to his best form he'll be right in it."

Saracino is raced by Wellingtonian Lib Petagna and Oliver will also wear his colours aboard the Kris Lees-trained Lucia Valentina (NZ) (Savabeel) in the Gr.1 Underwood Stakes.

"I haven't been on her recently, but I heard Kris say on the radio that he is happy with her," he said.

The rail for the Caulfield meeting will revert to its true position after it was out nine metres for the last meeting.

"It usually plays pretty fair when it's in the true position," Oliver said.

# PIKE OPEN TO A CAULFIELD SURPRISE

ony Pike isn't expecting a firstup victory from **Sacred Elixir** (NZ) (Pour Moi) in Saturday's Gr.3 Caulfield Guineas Prelude, but it wouldn't shock him either.

"He's a gorgeous horse and he looks fantastic," Cambridge trainer Tony Pike said.

"If he gets the right trip from the good gate he's probably going to be a winning chance, but I would still be surprised if he could win over 1400m at his first time around Caulfield.

"It's been difficult for horses to make up significant ground at Caulfield in recent meetings and we've always thought this race would be too sharp for him.

"We will be happy as long as he is

hitting the line strongly, though good horses can sometimes do unexpected things, but this is the first step in a big campaign and the Derby is the main aim."

Sacred Elixir is the early favourite for the Gr.1 Victoria Derby and is the second favourite for the Gr.1 Caulfield Guineas on October 8.

He will be ridden by Damian Lane, who is also booked for **Rangipo** (Styker) in the Gr.1 Sir Rupert Clarke Stakes. The Gr.1 NZ Derby winner will race in blinkers for the first time when he resumes.

"He tended to slip under the radar a bit and has always been underrated, but he's a tough horse," Pike said. Rangipo has not raced since making one appearance at the Brisbane carnival in May, but has had two jump-outs at Flemington to get him fit.

"There will be improvement with his first run and he looks great," Pike said. "He's really thickened up from three to four.

"It's a tough race to kick him off in. He will be better when he gets to a mile or 2000 metres and the draw doesn't help, but there aren't a lot of other options to start him off in.

"We are hoping the blinkers will sharpen him up and help him concentrate. He worked really well in blinkers last Thursday and again on Tuesday."

Entirely Platinum (NZ) (Pentire)

Entirely Platinum to appreciate class drop

**Entirely Platinum (NZ)** (Pentire) will carry the 58.5kg top weight in Saturday's Gr.2 Shannon Stakes at Rosehill after the withdrawal of Counterattack (Redoute's Choice).

Prepared by Hawkes Racing, seven-yearold Entirely Platinum is the veteran of the Shannon Stakes field and drops in grade after an unplaced run behind Palentino (Teofilo) two weeks ago in the Gr.1 Makybe Diva Stakes (1600m).

Before that he ran only a length away third to Miss Rose De Lago (Encosta De Lago) in the Gr.2 P.B. Lawrence Stakes at Caulfield (1400m).

Entirely Platinum is a \$5.50 third favourite in an open field which also includes Caped Crusader (NZ) (O'Reilly) and former New Zealand-trained galloper Cosmic Cube (NZ) (Dehere).



Samara Dancer (NZ) (Hinchinbrook) Samara Dancer out to press Guineas claims

Samara Dancer (NZ) (Hinchinbrook) can emulate an elder sibling by winning a

Guineas Prelude at Caulfield, but her trainer Phillip Stokes hopes she can do even better in her Group One finale two weeks later.

The premier Adelaide trainer believes Samara Dancer has improved going into Saturday's Thousand Guineas Prelude (1400m) after her third in the Danehill Stakes against the colts and geldings.

Samara Dancer's half-brother Eclair Big Bang (NZ) (Savabeel), who now races as Almababy in Hong Kong, won the Caulfield Guineas Prelude for colts and geldings at the corresponding meeting three years ago, having finishing third in the Danehill.

Samara Dancer has a wide barrier to contend with in the field of 14 and Stokes wants to see her relaxing and finishing strongly over the 1400m.

"I thought top five in the Danehill would be good so for her to run third was better than I expected," Stokes said.

"She's done everything right and settled in really well at Caulfield.

"There's still improvement in her going towards the Thousand Guineas and we've just drawn a bit of a tricky barrier in gate 13.

#### Black-type on Chaquinta's radar

Queanbeyan trainer Joe Cleary isn't worried about taking on the big names as he brings **Chaquinta (NZ)** (High Chaparral) to Rosehill for the Gr.3 Queen's Cup (2400m) on Saturday.

"[John] O'Shea, [Chris] Waller, we'll take them on," he declared. "We have a mare in form and they should be worried about her."

Chaquinta has won four of her past five starts and Cleary put her improvement down to some home-made hurdles and "long walks in the bush".

"After she ran fourth at Warwick Farm four runs back, I just tried something to sharpen her up," Cleary said. "We put her over the jumps and she has jumped out of the ground. She is a different horse."

Chaquinta's rich vein of form came after Cleary had to convince the owners to give her another year racing and it could pay off handsomely if she can get some black-type on Saturday where she faces just four rivals.

"I know they were benchmark races, and low benchmark races, she was winning, but she is ready for black type and she will get some on the weekend," Cleary said.

#### Savile Row out to press 2000 Guineas claims

Kevin Hickman could strengthen his hand for the Gr.1 Sothys 2000 Guineas when **Savile Row (NZ)** (Makfi) steps out at Ellerslie on Saturday.

The Valachi Downs proprietor bred and races the Makfi colt, a decisive winner at Avondale in June in his only start leading into Saturday's Gr.3 Manuka Doctor Bonecrusher Stakes (1400m).

Hickman already has a leading 2000 Guineas chance as a quarter shareholder in unbeaten Zacinto gelding Ugo Foscolo (NZ).

"It would be great if we could get both horses to the 2000 Guineas as live chances," Hickman's racing manager Jonathan Scully said. <u>Full story here.</u>

#### **Carolina plotting Guineas path**

Leviathan owner Lib Petagna will be hoping **Rosa Carolina (NZ)** (Savabeel) can continue his incredible run of success when she tackles Saturday's Listed Reginald Allen Quality (1400m) at Rosehill.

The Kris Lees-trained filly won at Gosford on her Australian debut and was narrowly defeated at Canterbury last start. Rated a \$6 chance on Saturday, Rosa Carolina pleased Lees with an impressive piece of work at Newcastle last Saturday.

#### **Derby hopes shaping positively**

Derby-winning rider Craig Williams steered the Trent Busuttin and Natalie Young-trained three-year-old Positive Carry (NZ) (Savabeel) to a narrow-butresolute win at Sale on Wednesday.

It was just the second start for the son of Savabeel, who finished second at the same track on debut.

Williams said the 2500m Derby was often not won by the best horse and Positive Carry shaped as a true stayer.

"As a three-year-old you don't have to be that good and he can stay," said Williams, who won the 2007 Derby on Kibbutz (NZ) (Golan).

Young suggested post-race that Positive Carry would next head to the Listed UCI Stakes (1800m) at Flemington on October 2, where he would be tested against some other Derby hopefuls.

#### **Queen Of Zealand joins Michelle Payne's** stable

Stakes-placed filly Queen Of Zealand (NZ) (Savabeel) has crossed the Tasman and joined the stable of rookie trainer Michelle Payne.

The daughter of Savabeel started twice for Hawera owner-trainer Wayne Jones, running seventh on debut before a third placing in the Listed O'Leary's Fillies' Stakes at Wanganui.

Queen Of Zealand will sport the royal blue and lime hoops, carried to recent success by last year's VRC Oaks heroine Jameka (Myboycharlie), of principal owners Colin and Janice McKenna.

Like Jameka, the McKennas will race the Kiwi filly with a large group of owners.

"Michelle has been really pleased with the way in which she has settled in," Melbourne syndicator Brendan Tohill said. "The fact

she is lightly tried and is yet to race beyond 1200m is a plus. She's by Savabeel and we hope she can be an Oaks filly."

Payne, who holds a dual trainer-jockey licence and won last year's Melbourne Cup aboard the Kiwi-bred stayer Prince of Penzance (NZ) (Pentire), said she was excited by the journey ahead and grateful for the support she has received thus far.

#### Trial win sets up another overseas campaign

Turn Me Loose (NZ) (Iffraaj) is on a mission to add to his collection of Australian titles.

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsmantrained multiple Group One winner will be on a plane to Australia in the very near future following his success at the Avondale trials on Tuesday.

Turn Me Loose was ridden in his heat by Matt Cameron and they cut out 1000 metres in good time.

"If he doesn't go over on Sunday he'll go the following week," Baker said. "He won his trial well and he broke a minute on a heavy track - he's still got it.

"He takes a bit to get fit as he's still a stallion and he's a big horse. He can jump out at Flemington when he gets there, they have jump-outs every week." Full story here.

Champion NZ 3YO Bonecrusher can count amongst his home wins the NZ Derby and Air New Zealand Stakes, followed up with stunning Australian wins in Sydney

including the Tancred Stakes and AJC Derby. In the following spring Bonecrusher won

the most memorable Cox Plate duel with Waverley Star – being described as the "race of the century". In this career defining race, Bonecrusher's name continues to live on in equine immortality.

Despite nearly dying following a bacterial infection during a trip to Tokyo, Bonecrusher came back to beat At Talag in the Australian Cup, again displaying a huge will to win and continued on to win another Air New Zealand Stakes at five.

Frank Ritchie trained Bonecrusher in all of his 44 starts for 18 wins (nine Group One, six of these in Australia), five seconds, 12 thirds and NZ\$674,225, A\$1,679,495 in career earnings.
