Group One winning sprinter **Tivaci** will add to Waikato Stud's outstanding stallion roster this coming breeding season and will stand for a fee of \$20,000+gst.

He is a son of High Chaparral and out of the Fastnet Rock mare Breccia, who is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Toorak Handicap winner Allez Wonder and the Gr.3 Chairman's Handicap winner Pretty Pins.

Trained by Michael Moroney, Tivaci was bought by Moroney's brother Paul for A\$250,000 as a yearling. He went on to win the Gr.1 All Aged Stakes before his retirement, as well as the Gr.3 CS Hayes Stakes, Gr.3 Sunshine Coast Guineas and Listed Kensington Stakes.

Last season's champion Australian three-year-old **Tarzino** will stand his first season at stud in 2017 at Gerry Harvey's Westbury Stud for a fee of \$15,000+gst.

The first son of Tavistock to stand at stud, Tarzino is out of the Zabeel mare Zarzino, a half-sister to the Group One-winning juvenile Kindacross and a sister to Gr.2 Perth Cup winner Respect and to the Group One-placed Kind Return.

He won four of his 14 starts for Caulfield trainer Mick Price with his career highlights including Group One victories in the VRC Derby and the Rosehill Guineas. He was also a close second in the Australian Guineas.

Triple Group One winner **Turn Me Loose**, one of Australasia's fastest and toughest milers, will stand at Windsor Park Stud in Cambridge this spring for a service fee of \$15,000+gst.

Turn Me Loose is one of eight Group One winners for his sire Iffraaj, who has also been represented this season by outstanding European galloper Ribchester and star New Zealand-trained three-year-olds Gingernuts and Jon Snow.

From an internationally successful family, Turn Me Loose is the only colt to date produced by Indomitable, a daughter of the breed-shaping sire Danehill.

Trained by Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman he was successful in the Gr.1 New Zealand 2000 Guineas. Turn Me Loose cemented his position at the head of the best milers of his generation with formidable victories in the Emirates Stakes at Flemington and in the Futurity Stakes at Caulfield.

VADAMOS

Rich Hill Stud will be the Southern Hemisphere home of the blue-blooded European Group One winner **Vadamos**. He will stand at the Walton property for \$15,000+gst.

The stud, with support of a high-profile group of New Zealand breeders, has purchased 50 percent of the stallion who will shuttle to New Zealand from 2017 onwards.

The French-bred Vadamos is the son of Monsun, who has made a significant impact in Australia by siring three of the last four Melbourne Cup-winners - Protectionist, Fiorente and Almandin. Out of the Stakes-winning Peintre Celebre mare Celebre Valada, Vadamos comes from a female family of high-class milers and middle-distance horses which has been nurtured by Jean-Luc Lagardere, the Aga Khan and Haras de Saint Pair.

Vadamos was one of Monsun's very best and he won the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin over a mile at Longchamp, the Gr.2 Prix du Muguet at Saint Cloud, the Gr.2 Oettingen-Rennen at Baden and the Gr.3 Prix Messidor at Maisons-Laffitte from the stable of leading international trainer Andre Fabre.

Preferment, a four-time Group One winning son of Zabeel, will return to his country of birth to stand at Nick and Anne-Marie King's Brighthill Farm next season for a fee of \$12,500+gst.

A brother to the Gr.3 SA Fillies' Classic winner Rezoned, Preferment is a son of the Flying Spur mare Better Alternative, who is a half-sister to the Gr.2 Villiers Stakes winner Dances On Waves. It is also the family of the Gr.1 Salinger Stakes winner Ancient Song.

Sold through Cambridge Stud's 2013 Premier Sale draft at Karaka, Chris Waller went to \$190,000 to secure the colt.

Preferment showed an early return on that investment for the champion Sydney trainer when he broke his maiden with victory in the Gr.1 VRC Derby and finished runner-up in the Gr.1 Rosehill Guineas.

The following season he won the Gr.2 Hill Stakes and at his next start claimed top honours in the Gr.1 Turnbull Stakes.

In the autumn of 2016, Preferment returned to Flemington to reign supreme in the Gr.1 Australian Cup and then back to Sydney to add the Gr.1 The BMW to his imposing record. He retired as the winner of five races and more than \$3.6 million in stake earnings.

BELARDO

Haunui Farm will welcome Champion European two-year-old **Belardo** to their stallion roster in 2017, where he will stand for a fee of \$12,000+gst.

The multiple Group One winner is a son Lope de Vega and a half-brother to multiple Stakes winner Berling, being out of Ireland's 2002 Champion two-year-old filly Danaskaya.

A debut winner at two, Belardo went on to win the Listed Washington Singer Stakes (1400m) at Newbury before capturing his first Group One in the Dewhurst Stakes.

His three-year-old season was marred by near-misses. Belardo finished fourth in the Gr.1 Irish Two Thousand Guineas, less than two lengths behind winner Gleneagles. He also finished third in the Gr.2 Challenge Stakes (1400m) at Newmarket and second in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes (1600m) behind Solow at Ascot.

At four he went on to claim arguably his finest moment with victory in the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes (1600m). He then finished runner-up to Tepin in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes in what was voted the best male performance of Royal Ascot 2016. It saw him retire with a Timeform rating of 126.

Rageese will join Vanbrugh and Turn Me Loose as new comers to Windsor Park Stud next season and will stand for a fee of \$8,000+gst.

Owned in partnership with Sheikh Mohammed Bin Khalifa Al Maktoum the imposing son of Street Cry is a direct descendant of champion race mare Emancipation and is closely related to Group One winners Virage De Fortune and Stratum Star.

He showed his quality early on as a two-year-old when runner-up in the Gr.1 ATC Sires' Produce Stakes at Randwick behind Pride of Dubai.

In his classic season, Rageese's spring form included a third in the Gr.2 ATC Stan Fox Stakes, fourth in the Gr.1 ATC Golden Rose Stakes and an unlucky fifth in the Gr.1 Caulfield Guineas.

He added further to his CV with a runaway stakes win in the Listed Nitschke Stakes at Morphettville and this season he scored a decisive victory in the Gr.3 VRC L'Oreal Paris Stakes at Flemington.

Vanbrugh will join the stallion roster at Windsor Park Stud this coming breeding season and will stand for a fee of \$6,000+gst at the Cambridge nursery.

A son of multiple champion sire Encosta De Lago, Vanbrugh is the winner of more than \$A740,000 and hails from the outstanding Waikato Stud family of Group One winners Diademe and Sacred Star.

Trained by Chris Waller, Vanbrugh won five of his 21 starts including the Gr.3 Gloaming Stakes as a three-year-old before claiming the Gr.1 Spring Champion Stakes.

Former champion New Zealand three-year-old **Puccini** will stand his first season at Mapperley Stud's Matamata property for a fee of \$5,000+gst.

A son of champion stallion Encosta de Lago, Puccini is out of stakes-winning Paris Opera mare Miss Opera. The quality broodmare is also the dam of six-time Group One winner Sir Slick and fellow first season stallion Verdi.

Puccini was the star performer in New Zealand in his classic season when, under the guidance of Peter and Jacob McKay, he triumphed in the Gr.1 New Zealand Derby off the back of Group Two wins in the Great Northern, Waikato and Avondale Guineas.

He came back the following term for Group Three victories in the Merial Metric Mile and the Thompson Handicap. He was subsequently runner-up in the Gr.1 Captain Cook Stakes and then went one better in the Gr.1 Thorndon Mile.

Puccini later had stints with Darren Weir and Wayne Walters in Australia where he was a multiple Group placegetter.

Street Cry's well-performed son **Telperion** will join Westbury Stud's stallion roster this coming season and will stand for a fee of \$5,000+gst.

He is out of the Redoute's Choice mare Yavanna, herself a daughter of the Group Three winner Wild Queen, who is a half-sister to the Gr.2 Ascot Vale Stakes winner So Gorgeous and the family of the great matriarch Denise's Joy.

Telperion is a half-brother to Golden Rose favourite Kemantari, an impressive juvenile winner for Godolphin.

Telperion was third on debut as a two-year-old for trainer John O'Shea. He then won the Listed Lonhro Plate at the expense of the subsequent Group One winner Prized Icon and was fourth in the Gr.2 Skyline Stakes before he filled a similar placing in the Gr.1 Golden Slipper Stakes.

He stormed home from the tail of the field and, in doing so, he recorded the fastest closing 600 metres of the race.

The handsome colt was then runner-up in the hands of James McDonald to the dual Group One winner Yankee Rose in the Sires' Produce Stakes at Randwick.

Unbeaten at two, Prince of Brooklyn won the Gr.3 National Stakes at Morphettville on debut from the leading Caulfield stable of Mick Price and he ended his juvenile season with further success in the Elvstroem Classic at Swan Hill.
